Scholarship amount of \$1,000 will be paid to the institution at the beginning of the second semester.

Mrs. Dexter Otis Arnold Scholarship: This scholarship is available to a **female** resident of the State of New Hampshire graduating from high school who will enter an accredited **NEW HAMPSHIRE** college or university. Scholarship amount of \$1,200 will be paid to the institution at the beginning of the second semester.
